Details

We welcome the submission of perspectives and opinion pieces focusing on Sub-Saharan Africa, especially the subjects related to **culture** and **religion**. Both topics can be explored jointly or separately if required.

Culture: We will welcome the papers which elaborate various aspects of popular culture, different forms of traditional cultural expression or present cultural or religious differences as a challenge for African statehood or regional governance. Researchers are also invited to submit their original research papers on culture and gender in Sub-Saharan Africa to the journal.

Religion: We encourage researchers who want to evaluate the changes within traditional or monotheistic religions due to the external cultural influences or underline the role of religion as a state-builder or a creator of cultural unity. In addition, research papers on the role of religious groups in Sub-Saharan Africa peacemaking and human rights are welcomed.

Those are the general guidelines as most of all we believe in the creativity of the authors who are able to propose interesting topic from the field of cultural and religious studies.
